






EVENT:	Giant Slalom (Ladies & Men) Saturday, February 7 & Sunday February 8, 2026 Slalom (Ladies & Men) Monday, February 9, 2026	
LOCATION:	Marmot Basin Jasper, Alberta (Runs: Upper Spillway/Upper Dromedary) Training will be available at Marmot Basin on Porteous Way on Friday, February 6, 2026. Team coaches are to coordinate amongst themselves. Potential for TFS on Dromedary after setup is complete (Approximately 1300 hrs).	
SANCTION:	Alpine Canada (ACA) and Alberta Alpine (AA)	
ELIGIBILITY:	U16 Alberta Alpine registered athletes	
RULES:	As per FIS ICR, Alpine Canada Alpine NCR, and Alberta Alpine PCR.	
ENTRY FEES:	\$150 fee for each competitor (\$50/day). Payments are due in full 30 minutes prior to the first Team Captains meeting on Friday, February 6 th , 2026. Cash or cheques are payable to <u>Snow Valley Racing</u> OR e-transfer to <u>programdirector@snowvalleyracing.ca</u>. One payment transaction per team.	
ENTRY DEADLINE:	Friday, January 30, 2026. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the ROC. Minor individual changes are permitted prior to the draw (injury, illness, etc.). No refunds after the draw.	
REGISTRATION:	Entries to be submitted through: www.alpinepoints.ca/ Out-of-province entries must be approved by their respective PTSO and Alberta Alpine.	
COMMUNICATION (COACHES AND ROC ONLY):	To communicate quick scheduling and event changes, coaches and ROC members are invited to join the official WhatsApp group for the race event: https://chat.whatsapp.com/GSl2glGrVxHJ9Pho7ygl3z	
DRAW:	Computer Draw: Evening of February 5 th , 2026, at the Lobstick Lodge. The Draw shall be conducted per AASA 2025-2026 PCR Seeding Chart). Any entries after the draw will be entered at the end of the start list.	
DEPOSITS:	All Alberta Clubs must have paid their annual teardown and bib deposit to Alberta Alpine.	
LIFT TICKETS:	One coach comp ticket per 10 racers. Entry fee does not include lift tickets for racers. A 10% discount for racers is available to competitors on race day through Marmot Basin. A reciprocal discount offer may be available from Marmot Basin through your ski resort season passes.	
TEAM CAPTAINS MEETING	Team Captain's Meeting will be held at 7:00 pm, Friday, February 6th, at the Best Western Jasper Inn – Sunrise Room . A coach representative from each club must be in attendance. All fees must be paid 30 minutes prior to the Team Captain's meeting.
